

# **ALL CHANGE AT THE TTBS**



t the Annual General Meeting at the Royal Air Force Club in London on May 4th the TTBS announced a number of changes and appointments to the Society's principals.

In his 80th year and after almost 63 years unbroken service in the timber industry, the last 12 of which were heading up the "Timber Trades' Own Charity", Ivan Savage TTBS chief executive officer retired at the AGM.

His career in the timber industry began in October 1960, initially with A Olby & Sons Ltd in West Sussex, subsequently with Cox Long Ltd Stafford, followed by the Timber Research & Development Association and as sales director with S Jackson (Walsall) Ltd and finally as group sales director with Carver (Wolverhampton) Ltd and as a director of the Carver subsidiary Engineered Timber Solutions Ltd in Rodington, near Shrewsbury until 2011.

He was appointed by the TTBS trustees in May 2011 as general manager and subsequently as chief executive officer in recognition of his outstanding contribution to the Society and the work to support the retired and long-term sick members of the timber industry and their dependents.



#### TONY SHELTON APPOINTED NATIONAL PRESIDENT

Tony Shelton of Allwood Trading Ltd, Bristol, has been appointed as the national president for 2023 and 2024.

"I'm very pleased to introduce myself as your TTBS president for 2023 and 2024," said Tony. "Along with Christella Golby, our new TTBS general manager, I'm looking forward to continuing the exceptional work done on behalf of the charity by our predecessors, Ivan Savage and John Taylor.

"I've been involved with the TTBS for over 20 years, serving the Bristol & Western Counties region alongside my colleagues, raising awareness of the Society, visiting recipients and enjoying some great events.

"I joined the timber industry with Taylor Maxwell Timber in 1985 after three years working for a toy and giftware importer in London. In 2021 the TM Group sold to Brickability plc and I retired as a director, creating a new venture as Allwood Trading Ltd.

"At the start of my career, I was frequently told by suppliers and customers that timber gets into your blood. It took a while but they were definitely right. Very few people leave the industry, and many go on to enjoy very successful and rewarding roles. The chance to give something back is where the TTBS steps in and presents a great opportunity to help those less fortunate than ourselves.

"The lifeblood of this charity is your continued support, both at events, but more importantly at grass roots committee level. It's vital that to maintain a healthy, functioning charity, the Society attracts new ideas and people, ensuring reliable financial support is maintained for the many beneficiaries from our industry.

"I hope to meet many of you over the course of the next two years and am committed to the continued success of the TTBS."



#### PAUL SNAPE APPOINTED VICE-PRESIDENT AND TREASURER

Paul Snape of WS Logistics Ltd of Ellesmere Port is appointed as vice-president and treasurer for 2023 and 2024. Paul is a past president of the Society (2019 and 2020) serving during the Covid pandemic, which disrupted his period in office dramatically. As a result, he has kindly agreed to return, initially to support Tony Shelton and then to return as national president from May 2025.

"It is a great honour for me to be taking on the role of general manager of the Timber Trades Benevolent Society," said Christella.



## **Obituary: Richard Thick**

Richard Thick, formerly of Vida Wood UK, died peacefully at home on Thursday December 22, following a brave battle against prostate cancer.

Moving up from Cheltenham to join SCA in the late 1970s, Mr Thick embraced the timber trade with enthusiasm, joining The Saplings Club and spending six months in Sweden working at various sawmills.

He became managing director of Boras Timber UK in 1993, which was then purchased by Vida Wood AB, where he continued in that role until his retirement in 2022.

He loved meeting people and was a great supporter of the TTBS, attending many functions and dinners over the years. He was a person of great character with a wicked sense of humour. His understanding and knowledge of the timber industry was second to none and to many people he was considered a mentor. He will be sadly missed by all.

He is survived by his wife Sharon and daughters Rebecca and Rachel.
